Taxi Data Reporting Requirements Extended to More Communities

Applicants in communities with 10,000 or more people are now expected to include data for 24 months or more (using Board spreadsheets) when applying for additional taxis. Taxi companies are reminded to store data regularly so it is available when making an application.

TLCI Review of Taxi and Limousine Rates

The Board has concluded its Taxi and Limousine Cost Index (TLCI) review for this year. No TLCI rate increase will be available for taxis or limousines in 2017.
