### Reminder: Toll Changes for Golden Ears Bridge

Effective July 15, 2017, when passengers cross the Golden Ears Bridge in a taxi, a taxi toll surcharge of **\$7.50** applies. The surcharge is increasing by \$0.10 to reflect the toll increase by TransLink. Taxi drivers must inform passengers in advance. The surcharge is added to the metered taxi fare. The amended rule, *Golden Ears Bridge Taxi Toll Surcharge*, is posted on the Board’s web page for [surcharges and tolls](#).
