2010 Measures End Today

We want to acknowledge the cooperation of licensees, drivers and dispatchers. We have received positive comments about people's transportation experiences. Demand was heaviest at night after major events. Flexibility on everyone's part helped meet this demand.

We would like to remind everyone of the following:

- All 2010 TOPs for taxis and limousines expire at midnight tonight
- All 2010 TSCs expire at midnight tonight
- All boundary relaxations for taxis (TBRT) expire at midnight tonight
- All seasonal yellow plates must be returned to the Passenger Transportation Branch at 104-4240 Manor Street, Burnaby no later than **April 1, 2010**, as per the terms & conditions of your licence and/or temporary operating permit.
- **Suburban cabs may no longer pick up flag fares in the City of Vancouver at any time.**
- The "*Board Rule Establishing Minimum & Maximum Limousine Rates and Limousine Rules for the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Games*" ends today.
- Starting tomorrow, limousine companies may only charge Board-approved rates that are in effect for their company.
