

I Background

The Golden Ears Bridge (GEB) links Pitt Meadows and Maple Ridge to Langley, Surrey and beyond. The GEB is a TransLink project. TransLink introduced GEB tolls on July 16, 2009. At that time, the Passenger Transportation Board issued a rule that specifies the GEB toll that licensed taxi operators could charge passengers. TransLink recently announced that it is removing GEB tolls effective September 1, 2017. As a result, the Board is ending its GEB toll surcharge for taxis.

II Rescindment

The “Board Rule Respecting Taxicab Toll Surcharges and the Golden Ears Bridge” (original rule) as amended July 15, 2017 is **rescinded at 11:59 p.m. on August 31, 2017.**
