## Contract Rates and Discounts

Taxis must charge rates that are set or approved by the Passenger Transportation Board. Discounts may only be given in accordance with Board rules or approvals.

Taxi companies who negotiate service contracts cannot offer or collect discounts on rates unless they have the following service limitation on their terms and conditions of licence.

Service Limitation: Service may be provided only to persons employed or engaged by **[specific employer]** and only as long as a current written contract exists between the licence holder and **[specific employer]** or its broker or agent.

This applies to contracts with Canada Post, school boards, railway companies, etc. If you want to negotiate rates, you must have the service limitation on your terms and conditions of licence.

To obtain such a service limitation, companies must submit an [Amendment of Licence application](#). Include documents that show you have a written contract or will soon enter a written contract. Other application requirements must also be met.
