## Update & Extension for Limousine Rates Evaluation

The Board thanks all who responded to its limousine rates survey in July 2014. Twenty five surveys were completed by limousine licensees or individuals working in the limousine industry. We are using this input in our preliminary evaluation of minimum / maximum rates that the Board introduced to the Lower Mainland and CRD as a pilot project in July 2011.

A full evaluation of the pilot project requires additional time. As a result, the Board has extended its milestone dates as follows:

- Nov./Dec. '13    **Survey Results & Board Response.** We will post survey results with a preliminary Board response and invite comments from interested parties.
- Jan./Feb. '14    **Industry Discussion Sessions** Limousine licensees will be invited to discuss minimum / maximum rates and the Board's preliminary evaluation at meetings in the Lower Mainland and Victoria.

The evaluation aims to answer these questions:

1. Should minimum / maximum rates continue in the Lower Mainland and Greater Victoria?
2. If yes, what adjustments should be made to the rates and rules?

The Board will complete its evaluation in March 2014 and notify the industry of any changes at that time. It is also extending the expiry date of the minimum / maximum rates pilot project until April 30, 2014. This will allow the implementation of review outcomes.
