Golden Ears Bridge & Taxi Toll Surcharge

Background

The Golden Ears Bridge (GEB) links Pitt Meadows and Maple Ridge to Langley, Surrey and beyond. The GEB is a TransLink project. TransLink charges vehicle owners a toll for vehicles that cross the bridge in either direction.

Tolls have been charged since July 16, 2009. The toll rates increased by \$0.05 per vehicle trip across the bridge on July 15, 2010. The Passenger Transportation Board is increasing the GEB toll surcharge that passengers pay to taxi operators.

Amended Rule

As of **Friday, September 3, 2010**, taxi operators must charge passengers a toll surcharge of **\$6.70** when a passenger hires a taxicab and is transported over the Golden Ears Bridge.

Taxi operators must advise passengers of this toll surcharge **before** the meter is turned on.
