TCI Methodology Update

The Board completed a review of the TCI methodology. Overall, the TCI is meeting its goals of effectiveness, efficiency and fairness.

After considering the findings and recommendation of a consultant, as well as direct input from stakeholder representatives, the Board is making adjustments to improve the TCI. Details are posted in the Board's Report on Taxi Cost Index (TCI) Methodology. Highlights include:

- The minimum TCI increase is raised to 2%.
- Temporary fuel surcharges will end and the Board's policy rescinded.
- TCI data will be reviewed every Spring unless there are extraordinary circumstances.
- TCI will be based on provincial data, not regional data.
- TCI implementation in some common rates areas will be adjusted to more equitably distribute influence over TCI implementation decisions.
- The Board will start posting the average and normal range of metered taxi rates that are charged by taxis in B.C.
- The Board will complete a review of TCI component weightings and related matters by Spring 2014.
