Submissions With Data From Multiple Licensees

[The Board publishes applications](#) it receives on its website. This gives others an opportunity to submit views and information to the Board before it makes a decision. Submissions are subject to a fee of \$50.

In practice, most submissions are written by competitors who oppose an application. When a single submission contains data or evidence supplied by more than one licensee (e.g. a group of corporately related companies), each licensee in the group must pay the submission fee. Alternatively, a single licensee may pay one submission fee and only submit data and information pertaining to its operations.
