

1. Background

- ♦ The Passenger Transportation Act allows the Board to: (a) set rates for the purpose of establishing just and uniform charges and; (b) to make rules governing how rates may be charged or applied.
- ♦ [Standard Rules for Taxicab Rates](#) apply to rates that are charged by taxicabs in British Columbia. Under section 10, the Board may approve additional, company-specific rules.

2. Additional Rules for Eagle Transit Ltd.

a. Point-to-Point Rates

Rates for trips to or from places not specifically named in the licensee's point-to-point rates shall be considered equal to and not greater nor less than the rate applicable to the last point named in the point-to-point rates.

b. Shared Transportation

If more than one passenger group is picked up, no matter how large or small the group, each party shall be charged an equal share of the total normally charged and rounded up to the nearest dollar.
