1. Industry Updates & Advisories

Camera Program Improved for Driver & Passenger Safety

The Board is updating its taxi camera standards and equipment approval process. Among the changes, the Board is phasing out the use of 2GB memory cards in G4 and G5 taxi cameras. Immediately, only cards 4GB or larger may be used to replace cards that are removed for any reason from a G4 or G5 camera. By March 31, 2019, memory cards in all G4 and G5 cameras must be 4GB or higher.

October 19 Deadline Approaching to Apply for Taxi Modernization Vehicle (plate) Increases
