Crew Transportation, Contract Rates and Discounts

Generally, taxis may only charge rates that are set or approved by the Board. They may only give a discount when the discount is approved by the Board.

Contract rates must be approved by the Board unless the licensee has a service limitation for crew transportation that looks like this:

Service Limitation: Service may be provided only to persons employed or engaged by **[specific employer]** and only as long as a current written contract exists between the licence holder and **[specific employer]** or its broker or agent.

If a licensee has this service limitation, the licensee and its client can agree on a rate without Board approval. If you want this service limitation, make an [Amendment of Licence application](#). Include documents that show you have a written contract or will soon enter a written contract. Other application requirements must also be met.

This policy applies to contracted transportation for crews hired by employers such as railways, airlines, shipping companies, oil and gas companies and the post office.
