Pilot Project Proposal Update: More Minimum Rates Options for Limousines

On February 2, the Board posted a [proposal](#) to start a Minimum Rates pilot project for limousines in the Lower Mainland and Victoria area.

The proposal includes a two-tier minimum rates structure. Based on initial comments from limousine companies, the Board has identified a five-tier option and a one-tier option. The Board presented these options at an Industry Discussion Session it held in Richmond on March 8, 2011.
