Limousine Rates Survey

We are asking limousine operators to tell us what they think about limousine rates issues.

On June 8, 2015, we emailed invitations to 161 limousine companies across BC to complete an online survey. **We invite responses until Wednesday June 17, 2015.** The survey asks limousine operators about a number of 'minimum rates' and 'standard rules' issues that affect their industry.

Most survey questions are the same for all limousine operators. They address issues such as package rates and minimum flat rates for point-to-point trips. Questions relate to all types of vehicles from sedan limousines to larger Perimeter Seating Buses (PSBs).

Some questions ask about issues relevant to a specific area. For the Sea-to-Sky corridor, we ask about flat rates that were introduced for YVR-Whistler trips, and a possible expansion for other trips on the corridor. For limousine operators in the Interior, Central, Northern and North Island regions, we ask about the possible introduction of minimum and maximum hourly rates.

Responses from limousine operators will help inform future Board policies about limousine rates. **If you operate a limousine business in BC, we hope you will make your perspectives known by completing the survey by June 17.**

Outcomes will be published in Fall 2015.
