Peak Season TOPs for Limousines—Festive Season

Peak Season Temporary Operating Permits (PS TOPs) enables limousine operators to meet cyclical demands or seasonal demands when additional vehicles are needed on a temporary and urgent basis.

PS TOPs are available over the 2017 festive season to operators who have not had or exceeded their PSTOPs for 2017. PSTOPs may start October 7, 2017 and run through **up to January 6, 2017**.

Fees per PSTOPs are as follows:

Length	Dates	Per Vehicle Fee
61-92 days	October 7, 2017 to January 6, 2018	\$100
31-60 days	November 8, 2017 to January 6, 2018	\$75
30 days or less	December 8, 2017 to January 6, 2018	\$50

The maximum number of vehicles permitted for a PS TOP is as follows:

Fleet Size	PS TOP Vehicles Permitted
1 - 10	1
11-23	up to 2
24+	up to 3

Licenses must indicate the maximum number of vehicles they are requesting when they submit a PS TOP application. Originating areas for PS TOPs will be the same as those on the applicant's licence. Vehicle capacity and type may be different on a PS TOP than on a licence; however the Board may limit the number of sedan limousines at any time in an area.
