Peak Season TOPs for Limousines—Spring Reminder

We remind limousine licensees that Peak Season Temporary Operating Permit (PS TOPs) are available through a streamlined application process. The Board introduced PS TOPs in July 2016.

PS TOPs enable limousine operators to meet cyclical or seasonal spikes in demand by temporarily adding vehicles to their fleet. Demand spikes may relate to ski season, grad season, wedding season, the festive season, or any other period in the calendar year when a licensee encounters a temporary and urgent need to add vehicles.

PS TOPs are available in set time blocks of 30, 60, and 92 days. Throughout a given year, a licensee may request PS TOPs in time blocks that total no more than 92 days. When a licensee applies for PS TOPs, they must specify the number of additional vehicles they want to operate. The number must not exceed the maximum shown in the chart below.

Fleet Size	Maximum PS TOP Vehicles
1 - 10	1
11-23	up to 2
24+	up to 3

Originating areas for PS TOPs are the same as those on the applicant's licence. The type and capacity of a vehicle allowed with a PS TOP may differ from a licence; however, the Board may limit the number of sedan limousines in an area.
